COVID RECOVERY DEFINED

*The following is the latest CDC guidelines for patients, to be considered recovered and staff, to return to work.

* **THERE IS NO RETESTING** once a positive test has been obtained.

FOR PERSONS WHO TESTED POSITIVE AND HAD SYMPTOMS

Symptom-based strategy

- At least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); **AND**
- At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

FOR PERSONS WHO TESTED POSITIVE BUT DID NOT HAVE SYMPTOMS

Time-based strategy

- 10 days have passed since the date of their first positive COVID-19 diagnostic test, assuming they have not subsequently developed symptoms since their positive test.
